

## **Application Instructions**

Enter all information requested on the application form - name, address, contact information.

In a few sentences, describe your Italian heritage; mother, father, grandparents of Italian descent. Include the Italian surname(s) of your relatives.

Indicate the high school you attend and the expected date of graduation.

Upload a copy of your high school transcripts or grade reports.

If you took the SAT, ACT or both, upload the test report form(s) showing the score(s) you achieved.

List the post-secondary schools you are applying to, or currently attend, and the field of study you are pursuing.

Upload a Letter or Letters of Acceptance from the post-secondary school(s) of choice (if available); if you have not yet received a Letter(s) of Acceptance these are not required now but must be provided if you are awarded a scholarship.

Upload three Letters of Recommendation from people who can describe why you are deserving of this scholarship. (Examples: School Counselor, Coach, Teacher, Clergy, etc.)

Enter, in the appropriate categories, activities you are involved in, both in school and in the community.

Indicate any honors or awards you have received, including other scholarships awarded to you.

Upload an essay, approximately 500 words (in Times New Roman 12) that describes how you meet the Qualities and Attributes described for this scholarship.

Upload an essay, approximately 500-1000 words (in Times New Roman 12) on one of the following topics:

- How has your Italian heritage influenced your life?
- What role has your family played in your life?

- Describe someone who has been a role model for you and how you have benefitted.
- Describe your career goals and how you plan to reach those goals.
